

# Air Toxics Rules Update



- **Boiler MACT – Major sources ( STAYED )**
  - Promulgated 3/21/11 - reconsideration of certain parts of rule
  - Rule amendment proposal scheduled for 11/11, and promulgate in 4/12
- **Boiler MACT – Area Sources**
  - Promulgated 3/21/11– reconsideration of certain parts of rule
  - Rule amendment proposal scheduled for 11/11, and promulgate in 4/12
- **Commercial & Industrial Solid Waste Incineration ( STAYED )**
  - Promulgated 3/21/11– reconsideration of certain parts of rule
  - Rule amendment proposal scheduled for 11/11, and promulgation in 4/12
- **Portland Cement NESHAP/NSPS Revisions**
  - Finalized on 9/9/10– Industry petitioned for reconsideration
  - 5/17/11: EPA denied in part and granted in part petitions to reconsider
  - EPA denied request to stay rule
  - Rule amendment proposals projected in early 2012; finalize 6-9 months later

# Air Toxics Rules Update - Continued



- *H.R. 2250 (Boilers and Incinerators) and H.R. 2681 (Cement Manufacturing)*
  - House of Representatives recently passed both rules
  - Both H.R. rules would nullify existing MACT rules (Major/area boiler, CISWI, Cement)
  - Requires EPA to finalize replacement rules within 15 months
- Coal and Oil Fired Electric Utility Steam Generating Units
  - Proposed 5/3/11 – Court ordered promulgation date is **12/16/11**
  - Number of affected sources: 1,350 units at 525 plants
  - Emission limits for units > 25 megawatts (PM, Hg, HCl limits)
  - Significant political interest could alter implementation
