Replaced 1, 073,000 Tons of Virgin Material

Used to Make New Ceiling Panels

Armstrong Ceiling Tile Recycling Program

Acceptable Panels for Recycling:

Mineral Fiber Panels

Fiberglass Panels

Painted Ceiling Tiles

Note: Armstrong will pay freight cost for 30,000 square feet

Must Meet Requirements for Pallets and Packing in Trailer

Not Acceptable for Recycling:

Asbestos-Containing Ceiling Panels

Ceiling Panels Installed Below Friable Asbestos

Red or Pink Ceiling Panels

Wet/Moldy Panels

Foiled Back Panels

Cardboard/Wood Panels

Gypsum Panels

You Must Register with Armstrong

You Need Original Construction Date of the Building

A Signed Recycling Agreement

**Letter by Owner, Certifying Original Construction Date and

(1985 & Newer Construction Only)

**Building Owner's Letter Provided by Armstrong
Certify the Owner, Address & Date of Construction
Attach Copy of Laboratory Reports**

Panels From Buildings After NESHAP's Ban of Asbestos is Unlikely
